Itinerary

Please eat a light breakfast before arriving at school.

6-6:15 am—No earlier, please. Chaperones will not be prepared to greet students until 6 am. If you arrive earlier please wait in your car until 6 am. Students may be dropped off in front of the gym, check in with a teacher in the gym lobby and receive further instructions. If a student ends up not being able to travel with us at the last minute, or you are running late, please have a parent call or text Mrs. Prieto at (813) 534-0166.

Charter buses have been reserved for students traveling to Kennedy Space Center. They will be seated at half capacity to maintain physical distancing. If parents would prefer to provide their own transportation they must notify Mrs. Prieto and complete the CDS Parent Driver Waiver. They should plan to meet the group at the main entrance at 8:45 am. If parents wish to attend Kennedy Space Center that day they may purchase their own ticket for entry.

6:15 am—Depart CDS for Kennedy Space Center! Students should have their mid-morning snack and drink packed and with them on the bus to enjoy upon arriving at Kennedy Space Center. No food or drinks may be consumed on the bus! In addition, no candy or gum will be permitted on the bus. We will be viewing Apollo 13 on our $2^{-1/2}$ hour ride. There will be no gaming, listening to music, or portable electronic device viewing at this time.

8:45 am—Arrive at Kennedy Space Center. Students will be dismissed from the buses by group to connect with assigned chaperones, use the restroom, and eat a mid-morning snack.

What to Wear

• <u>Wear to school</u> your gray CDS spirit t-shirt that was given to you at the beginning of the school year. If you have lost yours, please try to borrow one from a 7th or 8th grade friend or wear any other gray CDS shirt. Depending on the weather, you may wear shorts, pants, or jeans. Athletic shorts/pants and sweatpants are permitted. Leggings may be worn as long as your shirt is long enough to cover your backside. Comfortable closed toed shoes and socks must be worn.

What to Bring

- Bring with you on the bus a small backpack or crossbody bag to carry the following items:
 - An early morning snack and drink with a screw top, preferably water (No eating or drinking on the bus.)
 - o Hat and/or sunglasses
 - Camera (Can be a smart phone, iPod Touch or other small portable electronic device capable of taking pictures.)

- o Portable charging device
- o Earbuds or headphones
- Rain jacket or poncho (If rain is forecasted)
- Optional Spending money (Cash, gift card, or debit card)
 Keep your money on your person during the entire trip!
- An extra face mask
- \$15 vouchers will be provided for the students to purchase lunch at KSC.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All CDC and CDS COVID protocols will be followed. Students must wear masks at all times except when eating lunch outdoors.
- Students should not be in possession of any medication, prescription or nonprescription, without a doctor's approval. If students take medication that will need to be administered on the field trip, authorization for the administration of medication will need to be given. (Please complete the Authorization for the Administration of Medication Form.) Adult chaperones will administer all medications. Please turn labeled medications into the school nurse, preferably in their original container/package.
- Prescription and emergency medication kept at school will be traveling with us to Kennedy Space Center. We will also be taking a supply of over the counter medications. If parents have given CDS permission to administer over the counter medications at school we will be able to do so while traveling as well.
- Students are permitted to bring small, portable electronic devices including cell
 phones. CDS is not responsible for lost or stolen devices, or for the content and use of
 these devices. We trust that parents have set age appropriate restrictions on
 electronic devices, approved of downloaded content, and have reviewed appropriate
 use with their child.
- Students may not take pictures or videos of others without permission. They also
 may not post pictures or videos of others without permission. If a chaperone feels
 that a device is not being used appropriately it may be confiscated and returned to
 the parent after the trip. Students not bringing communication devices may be
 permitted to use their designated chaperone's mobile phone to contact their parents
 as needed.
- Students will not have access to Wi-Fi on the bus.
