We will be spending the majority of our time outside; please ensure that the School Nurse, Jackie Silvers @ CDS (Ext. 103) has updated medical information on your son/daughter. Teachers will oversee dispensing medications during the day for students throughout the trip. Buses will have common first aid materials.

What to wear: Our activities will be outside. Wear a CDS spirit shirt with jeans or school shorts. **Leggings, PE/sports shorts, and short shorts are not allowed.** Sunglasses and hats may also be worn. Sunscreen is recommended. We will go rain or shine, so be prepared if it is raining.

What to bring: please bring a drawstring bag or backpack containing:

- Sunscreen / bug spray
- Hand sanitizer
- Water-proof jacket or sweatshirt
- Optional: Spending money for souvenirs (\$25 is the suggested amount) Souvenirs can be purchased at the Manatee Tour and Dive

- Water shoes that stay on your feet
- Plastic bag for wet items.

Itinerary Details

Thursday, May 27th

6:45 a.m. Arrive at CDS on Elementary side, check in and get on your assigned bus with your drawstring bag. **Masks must be worn at all times while on the bus.** Sit one seat apart. Please eat breakfast before arriving at school. NO FOOD is allowed on the bus.

7:00 a.m. Buses depart: Buckle your seat belt and leave Carrollwood Day School. Water in your reusable bottle is allowed on the bus.

8:15 a.m. Stop at Rest Stop 346 on I-75 --15 min break - snacks provided

9:45 Arrive at Rosewood

9:45 - 11:00 a.m. Tour Rosewood with UCF Professor Gonzalez- Tennant (wrote a book about the Rosewood Massacre) and Mrs. Dupris (descendant)

11:00 a.m. Depart to Manatee Tour and Dive at Kings Bay. While on bus, change into swimsuit, sunshirt, shorts, and water shoes if kayaking. Additionally, show the manatee safety video.

12:00 a.m. Arrive at Manatee Tour and Dive at Crystal River (36 NE 4th St, Crystal River, FL 34428), eat lunch at picnic tables, use restrooms.

12:30 p.m. Water activity: Pontoon ride or kayaking (preselected option)

2:00 p.m. Kayakers change back into clothes and street shoes

2:30 p.m. Load buses and depart for Florida National Cemetery

3:30 p.m. Visit Florida National Cemetery at Bushnell, FL (6502 SW 102nd Ave, Bushnell, FL 33513) - Students will follow up on their biographical studies uncovering some of the hidden histories of veterans who are buried there.

4:30 p.m. Load buses and depart for CDS

5:15 p.m. Arrive at CDS - Elementary (East) side
