IB Curriculum Overview

- IB: 4 years of sequential & progressive credit in the 5 core academic disciplines (no gapping)
- IB & degree of rigor
- Seamless academic transition to college
- Diploma Program & Course Candidate: academic counseling & the best plan for each student





Extracurricular Overview

- Colleges are interested in:
 - Longitudinal participation (4 years)
 - Mastery of achievement/leadership
- Three to five pieces of (extensive) involvement is the goal
- Colleges love to see a variety rather than one specific area of expertise

Testing Timeline

- ❖ PSAT & Pre-ACT (9-11)
- ♦ SAT & ACT (11-12)
- PSAT & Pre-ACT results are helpful for the "test-centric" model





Strategic Positioning

- Grades: degree of rigor, GPA, GPA trend line, absolute GPA (class rank) & grade stratification
- Programming: evening presentations, Coffee with a Counselor, individual meetings (all 4 years)
- College assessment beginning in 9th grade
- College Counseling advisory class
 - > Assist with essay(s) & application completion
- Advocate & support in application process
- College visits (by staff & to CDS)
- Application strategy
- Financial aid, scholarship, FL Bright Futures assistance

CDS Success in Admission

- School profile (Cum Laude + IB)
- Class of 2020 SAT Average: 1277 (+90 points)
- Admission to more top 50 universities
 - Dartmouth College, Cornell University (2), University of Virginia (5), Northwestern University, University of Southern California, Georgetown University, Emory University, Tulane University, NYU, Wesleyan University, UNC Chapel Hill, Colgate University, RPI, Wake Forest University, Skidmore College, Lehigh University, Bucknell University, Kenyon College, Middlebury College, Boston College (5)



CDS Success in Admission (cont.)

- ♦ 100% admitted to a 4-year college/university
- 97% admitted to at least one Phi Beta Kappa school in 2019
- Since 2017, approximately 20-30 students are competing in NCAA Division 1, 2, or 3 athletics
- 93% received a merit-based scholarship in 2019 for a total of \$14,300,000
- UF Acceptance rate (2016-2020): 66%
- FSU Acceptance rate (2016-2020): 72%
