BYOD Technology at CDS

We have expanded the selection to include Chromebooks and Windows laptops in addition to Apple Devices. The reference page provides some recommendations for devices that fit within different budgets. We recommend installing antivirus software (Malwarebytes, Avast, etc.) on any device that you choose. Prior to the first day of school, students should be familiar with their device and be able to perform the following, basic functions.

- → Log into the device
- → Take screenshots of photos and videos
- → Locate and open files
- → Create folders
- → Upload, download, and share files via Google Drive
- → Launch applications
- → Download and install applications/add-ons
- → Update the operating system and applications
- → Troubleshoot basic Wi-Fi and connectivity issues
- → Force quit applications and restart the device



IB MYP Year 1/6th Grade 2021-2022 Supply Organization

All supplies must be opened and organized prior to the 1st day of orientation. Supplies must be labeled with the student's name and course name as indicated below.

The following items should be kept in a backpack, preferably not a rolling bag, and taken to all classes as needed.

- Charged laptop
- Earbuds or headphones compatible with laptop
- Pocket letter size accordion file folder with 6-8 (or more) sections (To be used as a homework folder for all classes)
- Reusable water bottle, preferably metal (Must be taken to PE)

The following items should be kept in one large or two small supply boxes/bags, preferably not plastic, and taken to classes as needed. Extra supplies should be kept at home, not in the student's locker. Students are required to replenish supplies as needed throughout the school year, especially glue sticks and writing utensils.
