You are not obligated to purchase any pictures from Studio Artistry; however, only official Studio Artistry formal graduation pictures will be published in the yearbook. Studio Artistry will also take a group picture of the entire class and will be at the graduation ceremony to take candid and formal pictures before and after the ceremony. GRADUATION CRITERIA & IB EXAMS: April 30 - May 20, 2021

A tentative schedule of IB exams is attached.

- IB Exams:
 - IB exam dates are scheduled to take place April 30 May 20 These dates are set by the International Baccalaureate Organization.

 As of January 2021, IBO has not made a determination on whether IB exams will be given this May. As soon as this decision is made, parents and students will be notified.
- Missed Exams:
 - If a student misses an IB DP exam, the earliest he/she will be able to make-up the exam is November 2021.
- IB Exams will be administered on campus this year.

SENIOR HONORING RECEPTION: THURSDAY, MAY 20

- Parents will be asked to provide baby and childhood pictures for a slideshow honoring the Class of 2021.
- The Senior Honoring Reception will be held on Thursday, May 20, 7:00 p.m.
- This event will be held outdoors on the CDS Bearss Avenue campus.
- Junior and senior parent volunteers may be needed to help decorate and set up for this event.
- Families will be limited to the number of guests they can invite, based on current health and safety regulations.
- Graduates will be complimentary; for parents and guests the cost is \$10 per person.
- Invitations will be provided by the school. Guests will be instructed to RSVP to their host/graduate family.
- Parents must make reservations for all guests, including graduate by **Friday**, **May 7**. Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate "walk-in" guests the evening of the event.

REHEARSAL: FRIDAY, MAY 21

10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

- All graduating seniors must participate in the full length of the commencement rehearsal on May 21 in order to participate in commencement. Seniors who do not participate in the entire commencement rehearsal will not be allowed to participate in the commencement ceremony.
- Girls should wear the shoes that they will wear to the commencement ceremony.
- In order to participate in the commencement rehearsal and commencement ceremony, students must meet all graduation requirements including: meeting all academic criteria, completion of all CDS service hours, turning in all books and athletic uniforms, and satisfying all financial obligations to the school.

COMMENCEMENT: FRIDAY, MAY 21, 2021

- The Commencement Exercises will take place on Friday, May 21, 2021. The procession will begin promptly at 5:00 p.m. Graduation will be held in Carrollwood Day School's **Wagner Athletic Complex.**
- Graduating seniors must arrive at CDS by **3:30 p.m**. for robing and class pictures. Faculty will assist the graduates with their robes and regalia.
- Graduates will **not be available** for pictures with family and friends until after the cap toss following the graduation recessional.
- Proper Attire for graduates:
 - No jeans, tennis shoes or casual footwear (i.e. flip-flops, crocs, or flat thong sandals) are permitted. Please leave all bags with family members. Do not leave valuables visible in your car, even if the car is locked.
 - Young Women: Underneath their gowns, young women should wear dresses, dress slacks, and black **flats**. Young women are encouraged to leave their purses and or bags with their families.
 - Young Men: Underneath their gown, young men should wear **white** collared, dress shirts with dark ties and black or navy dress slacks. They should also wear dark colored dress shoes and dark socks.
 - All school policies for dress apply; graduates should look neat and prepared for a formal ceremony.

GRADUATION SEATING:

• There will be a section of seating reserved for families of the graduates on the field in the Wagner Athletic Complex. Each family will receive tickets for the reserved family section. **Seats will be reserved in advance** for the families of the Valedictorian and Salutatorian and seats purchased at the annual auction. Additional guests are welcome to attend; seating for a limited number of additional guests will be available in the bleachers.

- A block of seats will be reserved for faculty and staff.
- Family commencement tickets will be mailed home in the packet containing the invitations to the Senior Honoring Reception.

FAMILY AND GUEST ARRIVAL:

• Gates to the Wagner Athletic Complex will open at 4:30 p.m. Guests are encouraged to arrive early. The graduation processional will begin **promptly** at 5:00 p.m.

<u>Please note:</u> Exams begin promptly at the stated times. Students must arrive 20-30 minutes prior to their exams to get settled in. Exams cannot be rescheduled prior to November 2021. If your student does not arrive at an exam, it will begin without them. Students will be admitted late to an exam; however, they will not have any extra time allotted to them. For example, if they show up 30 minutes late for a 60-minute exam, they will only have the remaining 30 minutes to complete the exam.
